On the heels of a successful show in Chicago, CONSTRUCT has opened the Call for Presentation for next year's event, September 11-14, 2012 at the Phoenix Convention Center in Phoenix, AZ. There are some changes to the submission and selection process providing more time to gather presentations while rewarding individuals who submit early.

The Call for Presentations takes place in three waves. Final selections including dates and times will be made by February 17, 2012.

- **Wave One** - deadline is **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2011.**

Presentations submitted by this date have best chance of approval and acceptance to conference program.

- **Wave Two** - deadline is **THURSDAY, DECEMBER 22, 2011.**

Presentations submitted by this date will be reviewed against topics needed to round out the program. Chance of approval and acceptance is less than WAVE ONE.

- **Wave Three** - deadline is **FRIDAY, JANUARY 20, 2012.**

Presentations submitted by this date will only be accepted on very limited basis. Submissions will need to be of exemplary nature.
