

Scholarship Essay Requirements

1. Essay submissions of 750-1500 words in length to include a title page with all the following:

- Your Name
- Contact information (phone, email, mailing address)
- The name, address, and contact details of your school
- Your current grade level (e.g., Junior, Senior)
- Construction Industry discipline that you are currently studying (or plan to study)

2. Essay Topic: The Future of Construction

- How do you see technology changing or impacting your specific discipline over the next 5+ years?
- What excites you most about these changes?
- What challenges (if any) will this create?

3. Essay Submission Process:

- Upload the essay and title page in a PDF format on the CSI Phoenix website.
- Please name your PDF file as “Firstname Lastname_CSI”.

Essay Rules:

All essays must be received before the May Monthly CSI Phoenix Chapter meeting (check event calendar for date). Essays received after this meeting date will not be considered. The winners will be announced in the September CSI Phoenix Chapter meeting.

- Each student may write each essay topic once. Multiple entries for the same essay topic will be disregarded.
- All essays must be unique. Plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
- Employees of CSI Phoenix and their immediate family are not eligible.
- All entries belong to CSI Phoenix. CSI Phoenix will have the exclusive right to republish any winning submission along with the name of the author.
- The winner is solely responsible for any federal, states, or local taxes.
- All prizes are paid in USD.
- The decision of CSI Phoenix regarding the contest results and the winner is final.
